Turtle Creek HOA Pool Rules and Regulations

- 1. No lifeguard is provided. All swimming is at your own risk.
- 2. No one may curse, yell at, threaten, harass, or intimidate anyone at the pool who has a valid pool pass or is accompanying someone with a valid pool pass. Such conduct will result in the individual (and his/her guests) losing pool privileges and being subject to fines.



- 3. Rafts or other inflatables are prohibited in the pool as they may present a hazard for swimmers and viewing capability for non-swimmers. This does not apply to water wings for unskilled swimmers.
- 4. Food and beverages are permitted on the pool deck only in non-breakable containers. **Glass containers are prohibited.** Inappropriate conduct due to the influence of drugs or alcohol may result in the loss of pool privileges. Intoxicated persons are not allowed in the pool or on the pool deck.
- 5. The pool is for the use of Turtle Creek residents. **Parties are not allowed.** Each card holder is limited to 4 guests and individuals may not obtain cards from other owners to justify the presence of additional individuals to host a party. You must provide the pool card when requested by a Board member or employee of Russell Property Management.
- 6. No diving allowed.
- 7. There are no designated parking spaces for pool use; please park in front of your own building.
- 8. No one is allowed in the pool after hours. A no trespassing sign is posted on the pool gate. Please notify the Police Department (252 329 4315) if you observe someone in the pool after hours. Any person trespassing inside the pool area after hours will be subject to arrest and prosecution.
- 9. Suitable swimming attire must be worn and showers taken before entering the pool. All incontinent individuals should wear appropriate protective garments.
- 10. Children under age 16 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- 11. No one is allowed in the pool with an infection, cold, or open wound.
- 12. Tossing games (ball, Frisbee, etc.), running, roller skating, roller blading, skate boarding, bicycle riding, or the like are strictly prohibited on the pool deck.
- 13. The use of radios, tape recorders, and musical instruments is permitted at a low to moderate level, as not to disturb other pool users.
- 14. No animals are permitted in the pool or pool area.
